## Itinerary

### Day 1 Thessaloniki

Arrival in Thessaloniki, the largest city of Northern Greece. Transfer to your hotel, and you can rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

### Day 2 Thessaloniki - City tour with museum

After your breakfast, you will take part in a panoramic tour of Thessaloniki.

This tour visits the distinctive cultural landmarks of Thessaloniki, the Galerius Arch, Rotonda and Saint Sofia, Egnatia and Aristotle's Square. Our bus will ascend to the Byzantine Castles at the top of the city where another world with endless



beauty unfolds. You will also visit the Byzantine Museum, the Church of St. Demetrios and its Crypt and the famous White Tower.

In the afternoon we will continue our exploration of the city centre and we will visit numerous monuments from the Byzantine period.

Overnight at the hotel.

### **Day 3      Mount Athos**

After breakfast, early departure to the picturesque village of Ouranoupoli to board the ferry for a mini cruise to Mount Athos, the mountainous peninsula in Chalkidiki, the most important centre of Eastern Orthodox monasticism. Mount Athos is home to 20 monasteries under the direct jurisdiction of the Ecumenical Patriarch of Constantinople.

Back to Ouranoupolis, free time. We return to Thessaloniki. Overnight at the hotel.

### **Day 4      Thessaloniki - Pella - Vergina**

After breakfast, discover the ancient wonders of Pella and Vergina on our full-day tour.

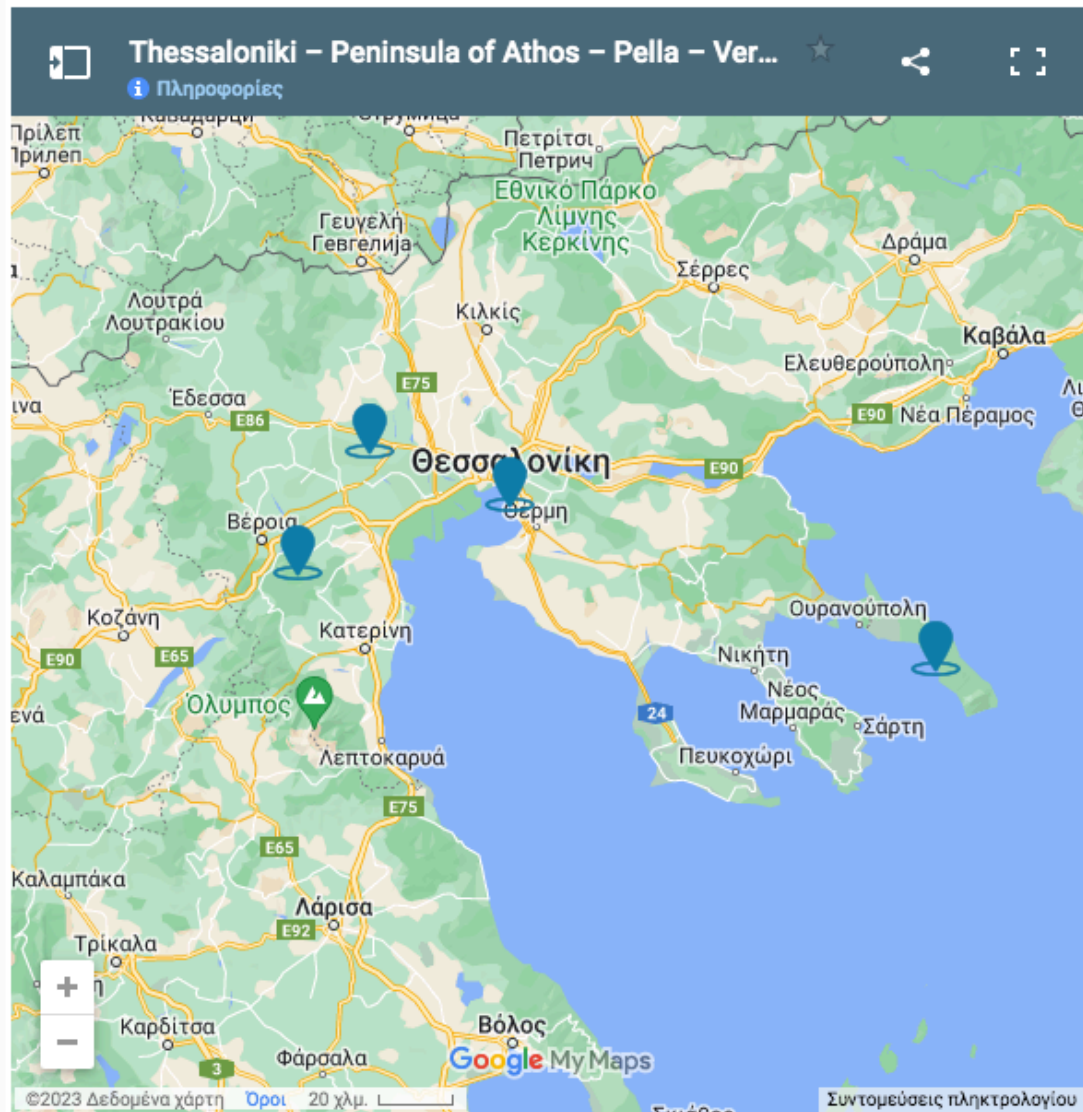
Begin your journey with a visit to the ancient capital of the Kingdom of Macedonia, Vergina. Here, you'll have the opportunity to visit the Royal Tombs, an archaeological discovery of enormous universal impact and protected by UNESCO as a world cultural heritage. The tombs, which were uncovered by Professor Manolis Andronikos and his associates in 1977, are housed under a modern roof and offer an insight into the ancient kingdom's history.

At the end of the day, we'll return you to Thessaloniki for an overnight stay.
